



Below are some FAQ:

1. DIVISIONS/GROUPS:

- **How do I determine which division/bracket is appropriate for my team(s)?** Teams will be placed into divisions based upon grade and gender. Any team or player determined by the Tournament Director to have falsified grade criteria will be dismissed from the tournament and no refund will be given. All players must be on the regular season CYC roster for a parish.

2. REGISTRATION:

- **How do I register my team(s) for the event?** The registration form will soon be available on our website at <http://www.sacredheart3on3.com>. Teams may fill out an entry form and return it to the address below. The following must be received before the registration process is considered complete:
 - a. Completed registration form / or on-line registration form
 - b. Completed Official Team Roster with waiver acknowledgement signature(s). NOTE: Parent or guardian signature required for each player.
 - c. Check payable to "Sacred Heart Athletic Association" for \$60.00 per team.

- **What is the deadline to register?** Register by August 15th to guarantee participation. If you miss the deadline and still wish to register, requests will be considered on an individual basis. NOTE THAT LATE REGISTRANTS WILL BE CHARGED AN ADDITIONAL FEE OF \$12.00 PER TEAM.



- **How do I know my team's registration is complete?** You will receive a confirmation letter via email. If you have any more questions regarding the registration process, please contact Chris Bullerdick via email at cbullerdick@sacredheart3on3.com or via phone at 636.861.0562.

3. ROSTERS:

- **How many players can I have on the roster?** You may carry a maximum of 6 players with a minimum of 3 players. Your team's entry fee is the same regardless of the number of players on team. Once you play your first game, players cannot be added or substituted on your team.
- **Can I change my team's roster after it is registered?** Yes. Changes can be made to the roster so long as all players are registered prior to their first scheduled game time, however, teams cannot make changes or add players once their first game has started. CYC cards for Grades 5-8 may be checked.

4. SCHEDULES:

- **When will the schedule be available?** Links to the Game Schedule will be posted on the website's home page <http://www.sacredheart3on3.com> by 5:00pm CST on Thursday, September 3rd. An email will also be sent to the address provided by each team on its registration form. **It is the responsibility of each coach to call if he/she cannot access the website or does not get an email.** If there are any problems, please contact Tom Connelly at 314.308.9423.
- **Can I request a specific time to play?**
Unfortunately, we will not be able to accommodate this type of request.

5. TEAM CHECK-IN:

- **What do I need to bring to Team Check-in?** Each team must check in at the administration table prior to your first scheduled game to pick up your schedules and t-shirts. All you need at the Team Check-in is your team name, a copy of your team roster, and CYC cards for 5th – 8th grade players.
- **Who needs to come to the Team Check-in?** Anyone can represent your team to pick up the schedule and event t-shirts for the tournament as long



as they know the correct team name and are authorized to sign for the materials.

6. **RULES:**

- **Where can I find the complete listing of rules for the Sacred Heart 3v3 Soccer Tournament?** A complete list of rules and regulations will soon be available on our website at <http://www.sacredheart3on3.com> .From our home page you will be able to click on the *Rules* link to our Rules Page. Also, the rules are attached in a PDF file. *It is the responsibility of each coach to ensure that all players read/understand the rules before the tournament begins.*
- **Are numbers on jerseys required?** No, but all players must wear similar team shirts (same color) during play. If both teams are wearing the same color, the home team (listed first on the schedule) must change to a different-colored penny.
- **Are there any player restrictions on casts or jewelry?** No protective casts will be allowed. No jewelry will be allowed, including earrings, necklaces, piercing, and bracelets. The only exception will be players wearing medical bracelets.

7. **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- **What do we receive if we win?** The 1st, 2nd and 3rd place teams will receive a medal.
- **What is the refund policy?** Entry fees are non-refundable. This includes, but is not limited to, cancellations arising from inclement weather, personal scheduling conflicts and inability to make a tournament. In case of inclement weather, the Tournament Director reserves the right to reduce the number of scheduled games and/or the time of games. - **What do we do in case of bad weather?** Cancellations due to weather will be posted on the website prior to 7 am on the day of the event. In



case of inclement weather, the Tournament Director reserves the right to reduce the number of scheduled games for the safety of the players, spectators and officials. Every effort will be made to update the website in a timely manner to inform teams of what decisions have been made in regards to the tournament. Entry fees are non-refundable. The pre-scheduled rain day is Sunday, September 6th.

- **Will there be food and beverages available on-site?** Yes, a variety of food and beverage items will be available for purchase.
- **Can I bring my own cooler and tent?**
Yes, coolers are allowed, however, alcoholic beverages are not permitted. Please note all coolers may be searched by tournament representatives upon entry per venue regulations. You can bring your own shade tent as long as it measures 10' x 10' or less and does not feature any offensive graphics. *The tournament and its employees are not responsible for any loss or theft that may occur.*
- **Who can play 3v3 Soccer?** Boys and girls of all skill levels ages K through 8 (entering the 2009-2010 school year).
